
GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Finland, 'the land of a thousand lakes', boasts of its breathtaking nature and overflows with biodiversity. Its stunning forests hide Europe's wildest animal species: bears, wolves, wolverines, capercaillies, black grouse, as well as elusive boreal lynxes, moose, and reindeer.

During this trip, we explore the Kuhmo region, a premier destination for wildlife photographers. We travel through its endless forests and countless lakes, focusing on bear and wolverine photography.

We've selected the best time for bear photography, capturing them as they visit the lakes to cool off. Multiple sessions are conducted in comfortable hides, designed for an immersive nature experience. All hides are equipped with double bunk beds to have a rest during dark hours.

Midway, we'll conduct a photographic editing workshop with Alexandra Surkova, enhancing our captured images and elevating them to a new aesthetic dimension.



TRIP ITINERARY_

DAY 1 (July 8th)	Arrival in Helsinki in the morning, transfer to Kuopio, overnight in Kuopio.
DAY 2 (July 9th)	Transfer to the bear hide at the lake, bear hide at the lake.
DAY 3 (July 10th)	Hide of bears in the lake.
DAY 4 (July 11th)	Transfer to the bear hide in the forest, editing workshop with Alexandra Surkova.
DAY 5 (July 12th)	Hide of bears in the forest.
DAY 6 (July 13th)	Hide of bears in the forest.
DAY 7 (July 14th)	Return to Helsinki airport.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 / JULY 8th

Morning arrival in Helsinki, transfer to Kuopio, overnight in Kuopio.

DAY 2 / JULY 9th

In the morning after breakfast, we drive for about 5 hours to the region of Kuhmo near the border with Russia. There, we find the hides dedicated to bears and wolverines in a wild environment. Upon our arrival, we can have lunch, settle into our accommodation, and in the early afternoon, we go to the hides where we spend the night.

Night – Bear Photography at the Lake.

We spend the night in the hide to photograph at dusk and dawn. A unique experience where we fully enjoy Finnish wild nature.



DAY 3 / JULY 10th

Around 8 am, we leave the hides and head to the base camp for lunch. Afterwards, we have free time to rest or photograph in the surroundings of the accommodation. In the early afternoon, we go to the hides where we will spend the night.

Night – Bear Photography at the Lake.



DAY 4 / JULY 11th

Around 8 am, we leave the hides and head to the base camp for lunch. We collect our luggage from the accommodation and head to our new destination, arriving at our accommodation by noon.

Afternoon – PHOTO EDITING WORKSHOP with Alexandra Surkova.

We conduct a theoretical and practical class with Alexandra, where you will learn how to get the most out of the photographs taken during the sessions and she will give you tips to make the most of the upcoming days in the hide.



DAY 5 / JULY 12th

In the morning, we have free time to rest or photograph in the surroundings of the accommodation. In the early afternoon, we go to the hides where we spend the night.

Night – Bear Photography in the forest.

We spend the night in the hide to photograph at dusk and dawn, where we can observe various specimens of bears and wolverines and, hopefully, a pack of wolves.






GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

Recommend telephoto lens (500-600mm) and a zoom lens like a 70-200mm. Wide-angle lenses for landscapes and close bear encounters.

Tripods aren't necessary but recommended for landscape shots.



CANCELLATION POLICY____

Should a client cancel their trip **after the reservation** deposit has been paid, they are required to compensate the travel agency. This includes **covering management fees** (incurred by the selling agency), **cancellation fees** (incurred by the organizing agency and service providers), and a penalty fee calculated as a percentage of the trip's total cost, as follows:

5% for cancellations made from 15 to 10 days before the trip's start date,
15% for cancellations made from 10 to 3 days before,
25% for cancellations made within 48 hours of the start date,
100% for no-shows at the departure time.

These penalties do not apply if the client arranges for a substitution more than 5 days before departure, if service providers allow the change. In such cases, the agency is entitled to a compensation fee of 5% of the trip's total price, plus any costs incurred for the substitution.
